One Thing:

• Our God is a God who is faithful in fulfilling all of His promises

Main Points:

• Thinking about God being a promise keeper:

1. God's Faithfulness

- Genesis 22:17-18 I will surely bless you, and I will surely multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven and as the sand that is on the seashore. And your offspring shall possess the gate of his enemies, and in your offspring shall all the nations of the earth be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice
- Jeremiah 33:17 David shall never lack a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel
- Numbers 23:19 God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?
- Lamentations 3:22-23 The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness
- 2 Thessalonians But the Lord is faithful. He will establish you and guard you against the evil one
- Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of or hope without waver, for he who promised is faithful
